Procedure:

1. Initial dispatch frequency will be used for Command (Communication between the IC and Dispatch)
2. Responding resources communicate with Dispatch on the Command frequency until they arrive on scene.
3. IC will designate one or more Tac frequencies for on scene communications (Tac 1, 2, or 3 for wildfire, Tac 4, 5, or 6 for structure fire and EMS incidents)
4. The only person talking from the scene to dispatch should be the IC.
